Steps to Solving Word Problems

- 1. +Read the question carefully several times and understand the key words.
- 2. Figure out what is given and what is unknown.
- 3. Search for information to relate relevant data to the unknown.
- 4. Use strategies to solve such as:
 - a. Draw a diagram or model draw
 - b. Guess and check with logical thinking
 - c. Simplify the problem, use tabulation or look for a pattern
 - d. Think of a related problem
 - e. Describe the problem in your own words
- 5. Read the question again to make sure that you used all the relevant data.
- 6. Apply the strategies and monitor your progress by checking each step carefully.
- 7. Check the result. Is it reasonable? Does it make sense?
- 8. Write your answer in sentence form.
- 9. In learning to solve problems, it is important to take time to think about what you have done. At the end of each problem, ask yourself some of the following questions:
 - a. What strategies did I use? Why?
 - b. What did I do when I got stuck? Which strategy helped me to move forward?
 - c. Did I check my work carefully?
 - d. What kind of mistakes did I make?
